

ORDINANCE NO. 72

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAGRAPH 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 25, TO PROVIDE FOR QUALIFICATION DATES FOR CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITION OF MAYOR-COUNCILPERSON AND COUNCIL PERSON.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 25 of the Town of Horseshoe Beach, Florida provides in paragraph 1 of said Ordinance;

"Candidates for the position of Mayor-Councilman and for councilmen shall be allowed to register as candidates for election from 9:00 a.m. on the thirtieth (30th) day prior to the election until the closing of the books for registration of candidates which shall occur at 5:00 p.m. on the 10th day prior to said election. In the event that the 10th day prior to the election shall fall on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the time for qualification and registration of candidates shall be extended until 5:00 p.m. on the next ensuing day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday." and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Horseshoe Beach, Florida, believes that it is in the best interest of the Town to extend the date for candidates for Mayo-Councilperson and Councilperson to register as candidates for election;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HORSESHOE BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT PARAGRAPH 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 25 IS AMENDED TO READ;

SECTION 1. Candidates for the position of Mayor-Councilperson and for Councilperson shall be allowed to register as candidates for election from 9:00 a.m. on the thirtieth (30th) day prior to the election until the twentieth (20th) day prior to said election. In the event that the 20th day prior to the election shall fall on

a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the time for qualification and registration of candidates shall be extended until 5:00 p.m. on the next ensuing day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.

SECTION 2. "Severability". If any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, sentence, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, unlawful or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect according to law.

PASSED on first reading after reading in full this 4th day of MARCH, 1993.

PASSED on second reading by title only this 4th day of MARCH, 1993.

FINALLY ADOPTED on third reading after public hearing on this 3 day of June, 1993.
